Please join us for a visit to beautiful Angel Island and a tour of Angel Island Immigration Station Museum led by museum staff and by our personal tour guide Judy Yung, author of *Island poetry and history of Chinese immigrants on Angel Island 1910-1940*, and many other works on Asian American studies, including a forthcoming book on Angel Island. Last year she and her husband, author Eddie Fung, led a fascinating tour of San Francisco's Chinatown, one of our first Spring Flings.



In the early twentieth century, the Immigration Station was a detention center where primarily Chinese immigrants were held until they could prove they were joining relatives already in the country. Many were detained for months or years and recorded their stay by writing poetry on the walls of the detention center. These vivid and emotional poems now serve as testament to the immigrants' experiences and will be featured on the tour of the Station.

Please arrive by 9:15 a.m. for boarding the 9:40 Blue and Gold Ferry from Pier 41 in San Francisco over to the island. We will then take a short shuttle to the Museum for an 11:00 a.m. tour. The tour will be followed by an informal lunch, when we can enjoy the beauty of the island with friends and colleagues. We will take the 3:50 p.m. shuttle back to Pier 41, arriving back in San Francisco at around 5:00 p.m.
